This certification is used to support a claim that you domicile in the Province of North Carolina and a Citizen of the United States of America Republic. You must domicile in the Province of North Carolina to be eligible for a Driver's License (DL), Driver Authorization Card (DAC) or Identification Card (ID) the definition of "domicile" is found in oxford dictionary.
